She asks for patience, confidence, and a need to trust while new configuration is determined. Mr. Weiss and Mrs. Lundgren are frustrated with not replacing Dr. Yates and also with lack of differentiation. The new model has not worked here. Dr. Harttraft said reform takes time. Mr. Piparo stated that we need to move on.
