8. EFT Claimant Certification (Electronic Funds Transfer)

RESOLVED, the Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's designee not under the direct supervision of the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible to review and authorize, in writing, the EFT payment of claim using an EFT technology that was initiated and presented by the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, and be it further

RESOLVED, an employee, non-employee, Board President, or other individual who is not under the direct supervision of the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall be responsible to review all EFT weekly Activity Reports on all EFT-based transactions.
