REMARKS FROM THE AUDIENCE (limited to 3 minutes)

The Public Comment portion of this meeting allows members of the audience to bring their concerns or comments to the Mayor and Council's attention. Pursuant to Borough Ordinance 3-2011, a member of the public who wishes to speak shall give his/her name and address for the record and may have up to three minutes to state his/her comments to the Mayor and Council as a Body. If additional time or information is requested, an appointment can be made with the Administrator's office during regular business hours.

Pam Ross, resident, questioned how much we are currently paying per student at Shore and Oceanport Schools – Mayor Kelly responded about \$262,000 per student at Shore Regional and a little less than that for Oceanport. Ms. Ross asked for an update on the status of leaving that district as we have spent a lot in legal fees fighting this since 2015. Mayor Kelly stated that we cannot opt out of the public school system, but we continue to try and form and join a new district with Highlands and Atlantic Highlands. Ms. Ross also asked if we have considered a voucher program which the Mayor explained is not an option for us.

Tammy Kaiser, resident, congratulated Councilmembers Keeler and Bieber on the election. Ms. Kaiser stated that when she was campaigning, a main concern from residents was the school regionalization and feels that we are not getting what we need from our current Attorney and maybe it is time to look for a new one. Regarding Ordinance No. 14-2024 that was adopted at the last meeting concerning the re-zoning of the Mad Hatter property, she wanted to reiterate that the Borough would get more taxes with residential property rather than a bar/restaurant and highlighted our current parking and traffic issues.

Authorizing Bonds Aggregating the Principal Sum Not To Exceed \$1,217,632 Authorized by Four Bond Ordinances Heretofore Adopted to Finance Part of the Cost of Various General Improvements in the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, New Jersey into One Consolidated Issue of Bonds and Providing for the Form, Maturities and Other Details of Said Consolidated Issue.

Councilmember Bieber offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption; seconded by Councilmember Catalano:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough"), has heretofore adopted four bond ordinances authorizing bonds to finance part of the cost of various general improvements in said Borough; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to issue bonds pursuant to said ordinances in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,217,632 and it is deemed advisable and in the best interests of the Borough, for the purpose of the orderly marketing of said bonds and for other financial reasons, to combine the bonds authorized under said four ordinances into one consolidated issue in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,217,632 pursuant to the Local Bond Law, constituting Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the Revised Statutes of New Jersey;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that:

- Section 1. There shall be issued bonds of the Borough in the following principal amounts pursuant to the following bond ordinances:
- A. An amount not to exceed \$51,992 bonds, being bonds authorized by an ordinance entitled: (Ord. No. 06-2020):

"BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$600,000 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$330,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING PART OF THE APPROPRIATION."

heretofore finally adopted. The average period of usefulness is 20 years.

B. An amount not to exceed \$67,400 bonds, being bonds authorized by an ordinance entitled: (Ord. No. 09-2022):

"BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$425,000 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$67,400 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING PART OF THE APPROPRIATION."

heretofore finally adopted. The average period of usefulness is 20 years.

C. An amount not to exceed \$53,240 bonds, being bonds authorized by an ordinance entitled: (Ord. No. 05-2023):

"BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$250,000 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$53,240 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING PART OF THE APPROPRIATION."

heretofore finally adopted. The average period of usefulness is 20 years.

D. An amount not to exceed \$1,045,000 bonds, being bonds authorized by an ordinance entitled: (Ord. No. 11-2023):

"BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$1,100,000 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN AERIAL TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,045,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING PART OF THE APPROPRIATION."

heretofore finally adopted. The average period of usefulness is 10 years.

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Section 2. The bonds referred to in Section 1 hereof are hereby combined into one consolidated issue of bonds in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,217,632 and are sometimes hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Bonds." The bonds referred to in Subsections A to D shall be designated "General Obligation Bonds, Series 2024" and shall be numbered with the prefix G from one (1) consecutively upward. The bonds of said consolidated issue shall be dated the date of delivery of the Bonds and will be issued in fully registered form. The Bonds of said issue (i) shall be dated the date of delivery of the Bonds, (ii) shall mature in the years 2025 through 2035, or such other years as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer, (iii) shall bear interest at the interest rates per annum as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, (iv) shall be sold at such price or prices as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, and (v) may be subject to redemption prior to their stated maturities as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, as shall be set forth in the proposal for the purchase of the Bonds acceptance of which is authorized pursuant to Section 5 hereof. The Bonds shall be numbered one consecutively upward, and will be issued in fully registered form.

Section 3. The Bonds shall be payable as to interest at the corporate trust office of U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association, Iselin, New Jersey, (or other trustee bank selected by the hereinafter defined Authority) payable on the May 15 and November 15 prior to each June 1 and December 1, commencing June 1, 2025, in an amount equal to the interest accruing to each such June 1 and December 1, and payable as to principal at the corporate trust office of U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association, payable on the 15th day of the month immediately preceding the due date therefor. Interest on the Bonds shall be calculated on the basis of a 360-day year or twelve 30-day calendar months.

Section 4. The Bonds shall be signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Borough Chief Financial Officer (each an "Authorized Officer"), by their manual or facsimile signatures, and the corporate seal of the Borough shall be affixed thereto, or imprinted or reproduced thereon and shall be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Borough.

Section 5. The Bonds are hereby sold and awarded to the Monmouth County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") by an Authorized Officer at a price determined by the Authorized Officer pursuant to the terms of a Bond Purchase Agreement between the Borough and the Authority (the "Bond Purchase Agreement"). The Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Borough to execute the Bond Purchase Agreement by and between the Borough and the Monmouth County Improvement Authority and the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the Borough and U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association, if necessary.

Section 6. The Bonds and the registration provisions endorsed thereon shall be in substantially the following form:

Both principal of and interest on this bond is payable in lawful money of the United States of America and in immediately available funds.

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As used herein, "Business Day" shall mean any day that is not a Saturday, a Sunday or a legal holiday in the State of New Jersey or the State of New York or a day on which the Trustee is legally authorized to close. "Late Payment Rate" shall mean a rate per annum equal to the lower of (i) the greater of (a) three percent above the interest rate that JPMorgan Chase publicly announces from time to time as its prime lending rate, such interest rate to change on the effective date of each announced change in such rate and (b) the rate then payable on this bond, and (ii) the maximum interest rate allowed by law.

The Bonds are subject to redemption prior to their stated maturities.

This bond is one of an authorized issue of bonds and is issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law of New Jersey, and is one of the Bonds referred to in a resolution of the Borough of Sea Bright adopted on November 18, 2024 and entitled "Resolution Authorizing Bonds Aggregating The Principal Sum Not To Exceed \$1,217,632 Authorized By Four Bond Ordinances Heretofore Adopted To Finance Part Of The Cost Of Various General Improvements In The Borough Of Sea Bright, County Of Monmouth, New Jersey Into One Consolidated Issue Of Bonds And Providing For The Form, Maturities And Other Details Of Said Consolidated Issue," and the bond ordinances referred to therein, in all respects duly approved and published as required by law.

The full faith and credit of the Borough of Sea Bright are hereby irrevocably pledged for the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on, and all other amounts due under, this bond according to its terms

It is hereby certified and recited that all conditions, acts and things required by the Constitution or statutes of the State of New Jersey to exist, to have happened or to have been performed precedent to or in the issuance of this bond exist, have happened and have been performed and that the issue of bonds of which this is one, together with all other indebtedness of the Borough of Sea Bright, is within every debt and other limit prescribed by such Constitution or statutes.

The Borough of Sea Bright agrees to pay (i) all costs and expenses (including legal fees) in connection with the administration and enforcement of this bond, which includes but is not limited to costs in connection with the enforcement of the County Guaranty (as defined in the Bond Resolution) and (ii) its share of the amounts payable pursuant to Section 9(vi)(B) of the Bond Purchase Agreement between the Borough of Sea Bright and the Authority.

Upon the date of issue of the Bonds, being the date of delivery of the Bonds to the Authority and the payment of the purchase price thereof in accordance with the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Borough Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed as of said date of issue, to execute and deliver to said purchaser (a) an arbitrage certification with respect to the Bonds under and for the purpose of Section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and (b) an accompanying opinion of Gibbons P.C. as of said date of issue with respect to said arbitrage certification for the purposes of said Section 148

Section 9. The proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied in the amounts and for the purposes provided in Section 1 hereof, and to pay and fund any bond anticipation notes theretofore issued for such purpose and then outstanding.

Section 10. The Mayor or Deputy Mayor and Borough Chief Financial Officer are hereby authorized and directed, as is the Borough Clerk, to execute all documents and certificates, necessary for the sale and delivery of said Bonds.
