ORDINANCE NO. 08-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT, CHAPTER 61, "ANIMALS", ARTICLE II, "CATS"

SECTION ONE: Chapter 61 "Animals", Article II "Cats", Section 61-12 "Vaccination and license required", of the Code of the Borough of Sea Bright is hereby amended as follows:

§61-12 Vaccination and license required.

A. Vaccination and license requirements. No person shall own, keep, harbor, or maintain any cat over seven months of age within the Borough of Sea Bright unless such cat is vaccinated and licensed against rabies.

SECTION TWO: Chapter 61 "Animals", Article II "Cats", Section 61-13 "Licensing procedure", of the Code of the Borough of Sea Bright shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION THREE: Chapter 61 "Animals", Article II "Cats", Section 61-14 "Restraint required", of the Code of the Borough of Sea Bright is hereby amended as follows:

§61-14 Restraint required.

No cat, either licensed or unlicensed, shall be permitted to run at large off the premises of the person owning or having the care, custody or control of the cat or to trespass upon the property of any other resident of the Borough.

SECTION FOUR: All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION FIVE: If any section, paragraph, sentence or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the reminder of this Ordinance.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.
