**AUTHORIZES THE BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT TO CONSIDER ADDITIONAL
LOCATIONS TO SERVE AS TEMPORARY FIRE HOUSE FACILITIES**

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution;
seconded by Councilmember Lamia;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Borough of Sea Bright's fire house is in
need of repairs due to Hurricane Sandy, and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2014, Resolution 49-2014 authorized the Mayor to enter into
a lease agreement for Block 17, Lots 1 and 2 for \$4,500.00 per month for temporary
fire house facilities, and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has determined that there are a number of vacant
properties in the Borough of Sea Bright capable of housing a temporary fire house
facility that should be considered, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea
Bright, County of Monmouth that it does hereby authorize the consideration of other
available properties within the Borough of Sea Bright to house the temporary fire
house, and


