RESOLUTION NO. 158-2021 A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE BEACH WAY OUTFALL IMPROVEMENT CONTRACT

Councilmember Leckstein introduced and offered the following Resolution for adoption; seconded by Councilmember Catalano:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright entered into a contract with Capela Construction, Inc. on March 16, 2021 for the Beach Way Outfall Improvements in the Borough of Sea Bright; and

WHEREAS, the initial Contract amount totaled \$33,800.00; and

WHEREAS, Capela Construction, Inc. successfully completed the terms of the original contract; and

WHEREAS, after completion of the initial contract it was discovered that there was no backflow preventer in the line which is now needed; and

WHEREAS, the cost to approve a change order for the initial contract will be \$12,500, which is greater than twenty-percent of the initial contract; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright has sufficient funds in the existing project scope to include a new backflow preventer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Borough of Sea Bright shall report to the Director of Local Government Services on an appendix to the contracting unit's annual budget this, and all other, change orders from the previous fiscal year which exceeded the twenty-percent limitation.
