

RESOLUTION NO. 85-2022
APPOINTING CUSTODIAN OF RECORDS
SEA BRIGHT POLICE DEPARTMENT

Councilmember Bieber introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution; seconded by Councilmember Birdsall:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 of the Open Public Records Act names the Municipal Clerk as the Records Custodian of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 of the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) does not preclude the Municipality from developing reasonable and practical measures for responding to OPRA requests, which measures may include the designation of another Custodian of Records for particular types of records; and

WHEREAS, as the Municipal Clerk does not have access to Police Department records, it would be in the best interest of the Borough to appoint a member of the Sea Bright Police Department as the Custodian of Police Records; and

WHEREAS, Brett Friedman, Sea Bright Police Chief recommends that he and Patrolman Andrew Hendricks be appointed as Co-Custodians of the Police Department Records; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that Chief Brett Friedman and Patrolman Andrew Hendricks are hereby appointed as Co-Custodians of Records for the Sea Bright Police Department.


