AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A TREATMENT WORKS APPROVAL PERMIT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR REPLACEMENT OF MONMOUTH COUNTY BRIDGE STRUCTURE S-32 OVER THE SHREWSBURY RIVER

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Commissioners and R. E. Pierson have retained Licensed Site Remediation Professionals (LSRP) to evaluate and oversee the process to ensure compliance with applicable Federal and State Environmental Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Treatment Works Approval Permit Application requires the consent from the Governing Body in order to file the application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, formally authorizes the Borough Administrator or Borough Clerk to execute a Consent by the Governing Body for the Treatment Works Approval for Replacement of Monmouth County Bridge Structure S-32 over the Shrewsbury River; and
