WHEREAS, on October 15, 2024 the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright authorized the receipt of bids for the Ocean Avenue sewer lining project at the Imbrie Place intersection MH4020 to MH4-21; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer did duly advertise to receive bids for the Ocean Avenue sewer lining project on October 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, three (3) bids were received from the following: 1) National Water Main Cleaning Co., Kearny, New Jersey in the amount of \$154,520.00; 2) En-Tech Infrastructure, Closter, New Jersey in the amount of \$357,981.00; and 3) Vortex Services, Freehold, New Jersey in the amount of \$281,650.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer and Attorney have reviewed the bid documents and determined the lowest responsible bidder meeting specifications for this bid is National Water Main Cleaning Co. of Kearny, New Jersey and recommend that a contract be awarded at a cost not to exceed \$154,520.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Resolution and the award stated herein is contingent on a similar resolution passed by the governing body of the Borough of Rumson approving the project and the reimbursement stated in the immediately prior paragraph and without same, this Resolution shall not take effect; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of this action shall be printed one time in the "Asbury Park Press" newspaper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk is hereby authorized to return all bid bonds and/or certified checks received from unsuccessful bidders; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this award of contract is conditioned upon delivery and execution thereof within ten (10) days from the date of the within Resolution accompanied by such appropriate insurance certificate, affirmative action certificate and performance bonds as may be required by the specifications; and
