

RESOLUTION NO. 111-2025
AUTHORIZING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
NEW JERSEY MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION AND THE
BOROUGH OF SEA BRIGHT FOR LIMITED ONLINE ACCESS PROGRAM

Councilmember Bieber introduced and offered for adoption the following Resolution;
seconded by Councilmember Leckstein:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission ("Commission") maintains computer records of certain driver license, vehicle, and vessel records of individuals licensed and vehicles and vessels registered in this State, hereinafter called the "database"; and;

WHEREAS, the database and the information contained in it do not constitute public records and the information in the database is not required to be released under the New Jersey Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 *et seq.*, but may be released at the discretion of the Commission in such manner as may be determined by the Commission to be administratively appropriate and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Commission in its discretion has established a Limited Online Access Program, hereinafter called the "Online Program" or "LOAP," to provide certain information contained in the database, via electronic communications, to businesses or public entities that demonstrate a beneficial interest in and legitimate business use of the database information; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright has requested from the Commission, Driver History Abstract and is within the guidelines of permitted uses according to the federal and New Jersey Drivers' Privacy Protection Act, 18 U.S.C. 2721 to 2725, and N.J.S.A. 39:2-3.3 to 3.6 ("Federal DPPA" and "New Jersey DPPA"), respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Sea Bright has demonstrated a beneficial interest in and legitimate business use of the database information and wishes to participate in the Online Program for a five (5) year term at an annual cost of \$150.00 according to the terms and conditions of the attached Memorandum of Understanding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Sea Bright, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, does hereby authorize the Borough Administrator to execute a five-year Memorandum of Understanding with the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission for online access to motor vehicle records through the Limited Online Access Program for an annual cost of \$150.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the following:


